

Panda-Pillow

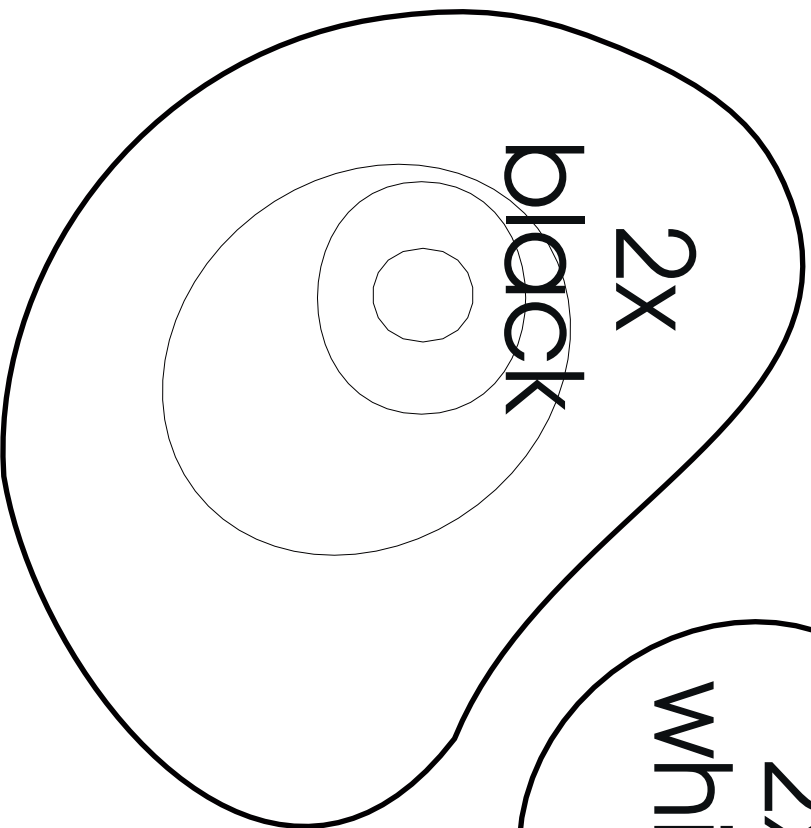


1. First, print the pattern (do not choose "fit to page" in printer settings) and tape the pieces together.
2. Cut all the pieces out.
3. Fold your chosen fabric in half (right sides together) and cut all pieces 2x (1x on folded fabric), ears 4x (2x on folded fabric)
4. Now appliqué the different layers on top of one another:
 - Stitch the inner ear piece to the outer ear piece (be sure to appliqué one right ear and one left ear).
 - Stitch the layers of the eye layer-upon-layer in the correct stacking order.
5. Place the completed eye pieces and the nose pieces onto the face piece and secure with a few pins. Appliqué the pieces onto the face (poly fleece or felt can be stitched on using a straight stitch; woven materials should be appliquéd using a zig zag stitch).
6. Stitch the line of the mouth as indicated on the pattern with a three-step straight stitch.
7. Stitch the ear fronts and backs to the face front and back, right sides together. Turn and stuff the ears.
8. Place the finished ears on the face piece at the marks, ears facing downward and secure with a few pins.
9. Stitch the two halves of the face together, right sides together. Leave a small opening for turning below the chin.

Stuff the pillow with poly fiber fill or cotton batting. .
Stitch the opening closed with a few blanket stitches.

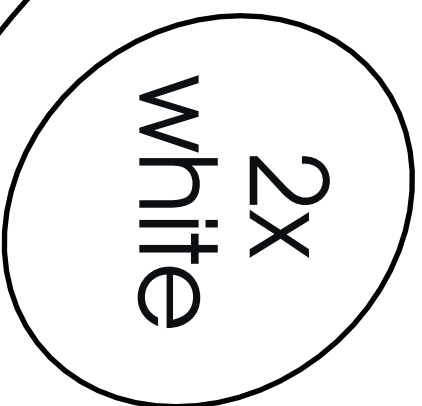
