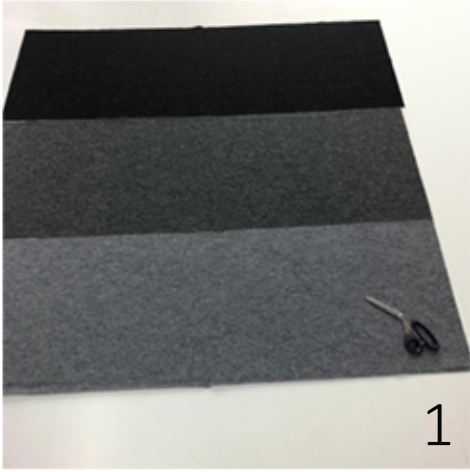
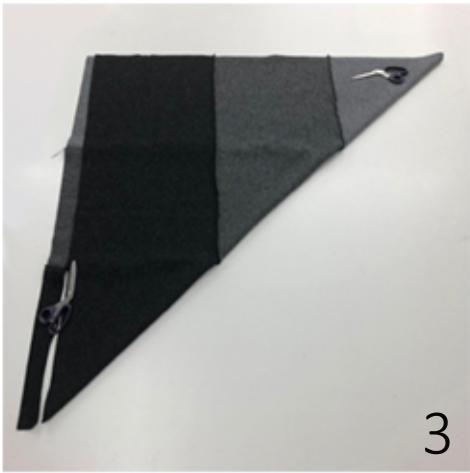


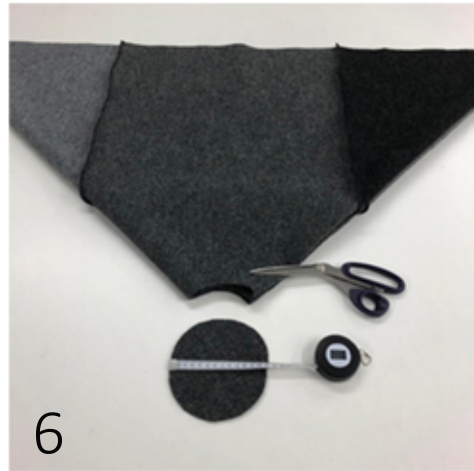
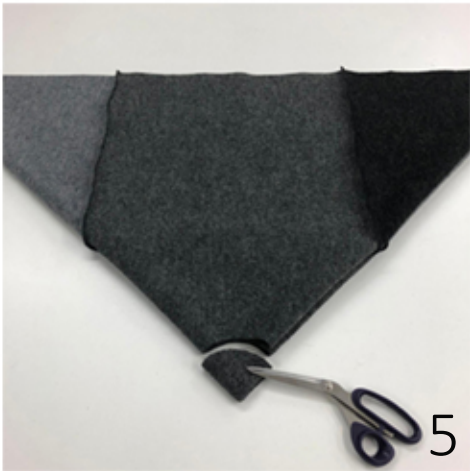
Make your own NAOMI Poncho!



- 1) Cut three pieces of "Naomi" boiled wool 50 cm wide across the entire width of the material.
- 2) Stitch the pieces together along the cut edges to make a square.



- 3) Trim excess material from the edges to make even.
- 4) Lay two opposite corners of your work together to form a triangle. Fold remaining two corners over.



- 5) Mark approximately 6.5 centimeters down from the center of the folded corner. Carefully cut a rounded cutout. The resulting circle should be approximately 13 cm in diameter.



Gently trim the opening for the head larger if necessary!

Finish the neck opening and poncho edges with bias tape, blanket stitches or however you like!

Or, keep it simple: "Naomi" will not ravel, so finishing the edges is not necessary.
